# RENTAL INFORMATION

Explore the possibilities of hosting your events at some of Wyomissing's most delightful facilities. The Stone House and Pavilions at Happy Hollow and Wyomissing Hills Playgrounds are available for rent to all Borough residents, providing ideal settings for parties, meetings, or reunions. Additionally, the Wyomissing Pool and Pool Pavilion are open for private rentals as well.

To reserve your desired date and facility, a refundable \$100.00 deposit is required, and reservations should be made at least two weeks in advance. Check **WyomissingREC.com** for availability and to make your reservation on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note that alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, and glass containers are strictly prohibited at any recreational facility.

# FACILITY FAQs



## Q: How do I go about renting one of the Borough's facilities?

A: Visit [WyomissingREC.com](http://WyomissingREC.com) and click on the RESERVE icon on the navigation bar then follow the prompts to initiate the rental process.

## Q: Is facility rental limited to Wyomissing Borough residents only?

A: Yes, facility rental is exclusive to Wyomissing Borough residents.

## Q: How long is the facility available for rental?

A: When rented, the facility is reserved for the entire day. Setup the day before is not permitted. Clean-up is the responsibility of the renter at the end of the event to ensure readiness for the next reservation.

## Q: When and where do I pick up the keys, and when should I return the keys?

A: For weekday events, pick up the key the day before. For weekend events, pick up on Friday (unless it's a holiday). Keys can be picked up at the receptionist desk at Borough Hall, located at 22 Reading Boulevard, Wyomissing. Keys must be placed in the black drop box at the facility upon completion of rental.

## Q: Are grills provided at the locations?

A: No, grills are not provided. You may bring your own gas grill, but it must be attended to at all times and removed from the facility after use. Please ensure a safe distance from the facility during operation.

## Q: Can I bring tents or inflatables?

A: No, for liability reasons, tents and inflatables are not permitted.

## Q: What is required upon leaving the facility?

A: Dispose of trash in designated receptacles, thoroughly clean the facility, and ensure proper closure, including locking bathrooms and the facility itself. Our staff will conduct a walkthrough to ensure all policies and rules were followed and that the facility is left in good, clean condition.





# THE PARKLANDS OF WYOMISSING BOROUGH



Wyomissing has a rich history, once inhabited by Native Americans from the Lenni Lenape tribe along the banks of Wyomissing Creek.


The name "Wyomissing" is believed to mean "a place of flats," capturing the area's flat terrain. Unique to the Borough is the strategic preservation of open spaces within residential areas. In 1929, founder Ferdinand Thun secured and preserved land along both sides of the creek, later designated as parkland in the 1970s.

The extensive trail network, composed of paved, stone, and grass paths, offers both short and long excursions, allowing residents to traverse the borough from the Reading Museum to The Highlands. The trails follow the picturesque Wyomissing Creek, leading to meadows, piney woods, and landmarks like Old Man Echo.

Throughout the year, diverse plant life, including snowdrops, skunk cabbage, wildflowers, and blossoms, adorns the landscape, complemented by lush meadows and forests. The parklands are a haven for wildlife, hosting deer, eagles, brown trout, painted turtles, and various freshwater invertebrates in the Wyomissing Creek.

In the words of 16th-century physician Paracelsus, "The art of healing comes from nature, not from the physician." Wyomissing Parklands provide a natural connection proven to alleviate stress, strengthen relationships, and enhance mental well-being.

# DID YOU KNOW?



Discover the rich history of the Stone House, which played a vital role in the Amish-Mennonite migration to Pennsylvania in the mid-1700s.

Originally settled by the Welsh in the 1720s, the Wyomissing and Tulpehocken Creek valleys saw an influx of people escaping religious persecution in Switzerland and Germany during the mid-1700s. Among

the migrants was Christian Schmucker, who, in 1752, arrived in Philadelphia. His son, John, acquired the land where the Stone House stands today as a gift from his father-in-law, Nicholas Stoltzfus.

Barbara Stoltzfus married John Schmucker, an Amish native of Switzerland, born on September 24, 1740, who arrived in Philadelphia on May 8, 1752. Barbara and John Schmucker had thirteen children and lived on a farm west of Reading, Pennsylvania, now known as the 'Stone House' in Wyomissing. This farm was originally owned by Nicholas and Christian and was passed on to John and Barbara.

Constructed around 1783-88, the Stone House is a classic 2½-story Pennsylvania limestone farmhouse with thick walls, a shingled roof, and four bays. Though the interior has undergone significant changes, it originally featured one or two rooms deep, likely divided into two or three rooms with a gable fireplace. The house is tied to the Schmucker family, whose descendants gained fame for their jams and jellies.

The preservation of the Stone House began with Ferdinand Thun, a visionary co-founder of Wyomissing. He transformed the property into a park along the Wyomissing Creek, including the creation of the beloved skating pond in 1946, later expanded in 1960. Thun's vision aimed at establishing a model community with recreational opportunities for all, making the Stone House a cornerstone of Wyomissing's history.

Today, the historic Stone House and its scenic lawn area serve as the backdrop for several of the Borough's Recreation Department's events and activities. From the Annual Lighting of the Greens and Holiday Marketplace to the central hub for the Trout Fishing Rodeo, the Stone House remains a vibrant part of our community. Additionally, its charming ambiance makes it a popular choice for hosting parties and family get-togethers, connecting the past with the present in the heart of Wyomissing.
